

Getting to and from the airport by train, taxi or limousine:

S-Bahn

Clean, comfortable electric *Schnellbahn* trains depart from an underground station near München Airport Center's entrance. Look for the S-Bahn's vending machines, or pay your fare to an agent at the railroad ticket counter.

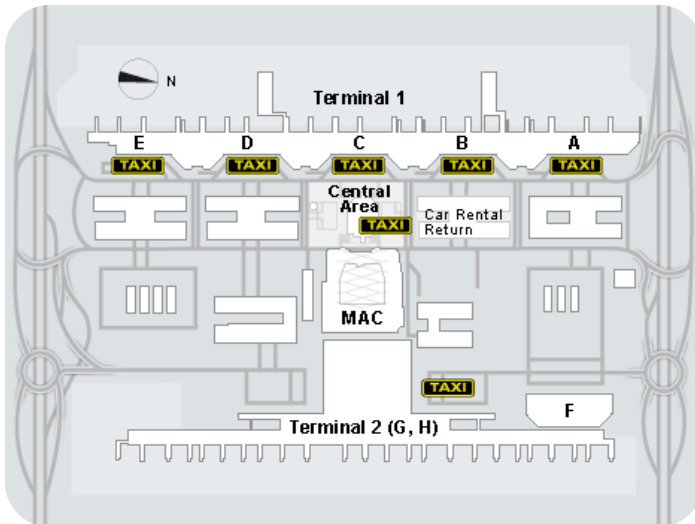
The trip into central Munich takes about 40 minutes, depending on your train and destination. Six trains depart every hour from early morning through late evening.

To board a train, simply head for the platform and catch the next S1 or S8 train. Once you're in the train, you'll find a map that shows the entire system. You can also get free pocket maps from the airport's literature rack or a ticket agent.

Taxi Information:

Depending on their needs, passengers can choose from among the following vehicle types: sedan, station wagon, minibus (up to eight persons) etc. Passengers can choose to travel in a smoking or non-smoking vehicle. Payment is calculated per taxi and not per person.

Limousine Services:

Limousine services offer transportation to a large number of destinations around Munich Airport. Transfer services usually offer tickets by seat, whereas limousine services offer a more exclusive and thus individual mode of transport.
